- Give yourself permission to leave your work behind and truly engage in the sessions. A WLI session is not just one more meeting in the day...it's your professional development.
- Complete the 360 Leadership Practices Inventory.
- Leave your cell phone in your purse/briefcase and mute it to avoid distracting yourself and other participants.
- Attend all sessions. Remember, a significant fee is paid for your participation in WLI.
- Arrive on time and stay through the end of each session. Your time is valuable and we promise not to waste it. Remember, our counts for refreshments and materials are based on your being in attendance.
- Allow yourself plenty of travel time so that you can arrive, park and get settled at least a few minutes before the scheduled start time. We encourage you to carpool when possible. You'll be surprised how well you'll get to know your colleagues and how helpful that will be in the future.
- Make sure you are fully engaged in the group work. This is an outstanding opportunity to build your network and to engage a wider audience on topics critical to their development.
- Have fun, ask questions, and continue your development beyond sessions by enhancing your professional network with your classmates.
