Buffalo is a top 20 city when it comes to higher education for people ages 18-to-34.

That is according to an analysis of figures from the <u>U.S. Census Bureau</u> compiled by On Numbers, a daily demographic blog from American City Business Journals.

There are 69,075 people in the 18-to-34 range within the Buffalo Niagara region that hold a bachelor's degree or higher, representing 27.79 percent.

Rochester ranked 30th with 59,101 college grads, or 25 percent, out of 236,387 people in the age classification.

The percentage of college-educated young adults — 39.2 percent — is larger in the Boston area than anywhere else in America.
